



Painting with flowers

What you will need:

- paint
- stemmed flowers such as dandelions and daisies
- paper

How to carry out the activity:

- We collect various flowers such as dandelions, daisies.
- Give the children paint and instead of brushes, they will use flowers to paint and discover different strokes and lines that they are making.



Flower ice cubes

What you'll need:

- small flowers or petals
- ice cube tray
- water

How to carry out the activity:

- We put small flowers/petals in an ice cube tray.
- Fill the tray with water and freeze.
- Let the children expose and observe the flowers from various points of view.



Colour changing flowers activity

What you will need:

- White carnations
- Food Colouring
- See through plastic cups/glasses

How to carry out the activity:

- To start you will want to trim down the stems of the flower, so they fit your cups or glasses.
- Add water to each cup.
- Then put about 10-15 drops of food colouring in the water and stir around a bit.
- Add at least one carnation to each glass of coloured water.
- Check in on the flowers every couple of hours and observe any changes.
