Ice Play Activities





What you will need:

- Balloons
- Food colouring of your choice
- Water

How to carry out the activity:

- Fill the balloons with water and put in a colour of your choice.
- Tie the balloons and put them in the freezer overnight.
- Once they are frozen, cut the balloon off and you have giant coloured ice marbles.

Ice Play Activities





What you will need:

- Ice cube tray
- Food colouring of your choice
- Water

How to carry out the activity:

- Fill the ice cube tray with water and put in a colour of your choice.
- Put in the ice cube tray in the freezer overnight.
- Once frozen pop out the cubes and allow the children to explore, watching as the ice cube changes.

Ice Play Activities





What you'll need

- Ice cube tray
- paint
- Lollipop sticks
- Paper

How to carry out the activity:

- Put the paint into the sections of an ice cube tray, filling each section a third of the way.
- Continue to fill the tray with water.
- Give each section a little stir to semi mix the paint and water together.
- Place the ice cube tray in the freezer.
- To add the handles Check on your ice cube tray after about 30 minutes. When the mixture is half-frozen, stick a handle into the centre of each ice cube.
