



Ingredients

- 2 cups flour
- 4 tsp cream of tartar
- 1 cup salt
- 2 cups water
- 4 tbsp vegetable oil
- Food colouring and essential oils optional

How To Make Homemade Play Dough

- Mix flour, cream of tartar and salt into a large pot.
- Add water and oil.
- Over medium heat, cook and stir constantly until it forms a ball.
- Remove from heat and store in airtight container.

A fun thing to do with this recipe is added food colouring. Only add a couple of drops to mix in, or you will have a mess. I also love adding a few drops of essential oils into the mix.



What you will need:

- 1 cup Flour
- 1 cup Fine Sand
- $\frac{1}{4}$ cup Salt
- 1 Tbsp. Cream of Tartar
- 1 Tbsp. Vegetable Oil
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup Boiling Water
- Shells, Small Glass Stones

How To Make Homemade Play Dough

- In a large bowl, mix the flour, sand, salt, and cream of tartar.
- Add the oil and water and mix well.
- Knead the dough for 1-2 minutes until it is all smooth.
- Mix in some shells and glass stones and have fun moulding and playing with the sand playdough. Just like playing at the beach but this sand holds its shape!



What you will need:

- 1 cup Cornflour
- 1/2 cup Hair Conditioner
 - Mixing bowl
 - Measuring cup
- Mixing spoon (optional)
- Food colouring (optional)

How To Make Homemade Cloud Dough

- In your mixing bowl put in one cup of cornflour.
- Next add 1/2 cup of hair conditioner.
- Mix it all together well, until it becomes a dough. At some point during the mixing process the mixing spoon will become unusable because of how thick the dough gets. Set it to the side and dig in with your hands. You will want to knead the dough for a couple minutes.
- If you find the dough is still a bit sticky after you have mixed it, add a touch more corn flour and mix it in. Be careful when doing this though because if you add too much cornflour to the dough, it will become crumbly. Just add a little bit at a time until it is not sticking to your hands.
- If you decide you want to add colour to your cloud dough, divide the dough out into sections and pick a colour for each section. Start with just one drop of food colouring and adding more as desired.
